Dakota County CDA Workforce Housing Program

The Workforce Housing Program is designed for moderate-income families with children under the age of 18 and provides affordable one-, two- or three-bedroom townhomes in nine of the major cities in Dakota County.

Program Eligibility

- Applicants must have incomes below the following limits by household size:

Household Size	Preference Income	Maximum Income
1	\$33,050	\$39,660
2	\$37,750	\$45,300
3	\$42,450	\$50,940
4	\$47,150	\$56,580
5	\$50,950	\$61,140
6	\$54,700	\$65,640

- Applicants must also meet minimum income requirements:
 - 1 bedroom applicants: \$17,592
 - 2 bedroom applicants: \$20,232
 - 3 bedroom applicants: \$22,608
- If you receive rental assistance, minimum income requirements do not apply.

- Preference is given to applicants who currently live, work, are hired to work, or attend school (full-time) in Dakota County and whose incomes are between the minimum and preference income limits for the program.

How to Apply

Interested applicants can apply *online* using any device with internet access, including computers, laptops, tablets or smart phones.

- *If you do not have access to the internet, you can access computers at public libraries or at the CDA's office (located at 1228 Town Centre Drive, Eagan)*
- *Applications can be submitted at the CDA's office weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.*

- Create a CDA MyHousing account username and password. You must have an email address to create an account.
 - *Only one application per household.*
 - *The head/co-head of household must have date of birth and a Social Security Number.*
 - *Application can be translated into other languages.*
