Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Officers arrested a 33-year-old male for 2nd Degree Assault, Threats of Violence, and two (2) counts of 5th Degree Assault.
- Patrol responded to a Suspicious Vehicle call and discovered it was a confirmed stolen vehicle out of Savage.
- Patrol responded to a Domestic call and placed a KOPS alert on a 27-year-old male for 2nd Degree Assault and DANCO Violation. He was arrested the following day by Austin PD.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported from 16XXX Innsbrook Drive. Cash, credit cards and an iPhone were stolen.
- A Hit and Run Traffic Accident was reported at 17XXX Cedar Avenue.
- Theft of construction materials was reported from 18XXX Harlow Path.
- Responding to a Domestic call, Officers arrested a 32-year-old female for Felony Strangulation and 5th Degree Domestic Assault.
- A Traffic Stop, on Dodd Boulevard, resulted in the 4th Degree DWI arrest of a 43-year-old male. He showed signs of impairment, failed SFST's and tested a .14 BAC.
- Burglary was reported at 20XXX Kaftan Court. The garage door was left open and two unknown females entered the garage and took numerous items.
- Officers were called to 18XXX Knollwood Circle on a Theft in Progress. The victim reported he had just witnessed a male steal mail from his, and his neighbor's, mailbox. He provided a vehicle description and license plate of the suspect vehicle. Upon arrival, Officers located the suspect vehicle parked nearby and made contact with the 33-year-old driver. A records check revealed he had a Felony Warrant out of Scott County for Check Forgery. His vehicle was impounded, and a search yielded drug paraphernalia and suspected methamphetamine. He was jailed on his Warrant and Charged with Felony Mail Theft.
- Patrol responded to a two-vehicle Property Damage Traffic Accident at 185th Street West and Ipava Avenue. The 62-year-old at-fault male driver showed signs of impairment, ultimately testing a .17 BAC. He was jailed on 3rd Degree DWI charges.
- Patrol responded to a Stolen Vehicle at 21XXX Glade Avenue. The victim left it running while running into the store. Seconds later, he observed a male enter the vehicle and leave the parking lot at a high rate of speed. As luck would have it, the victim's phone was also in the vehicle, which allowed it to be tracked to the area of Lakeville North High School. The vehicle was found unoccupied, and Patrol located a person matching the suspect's description nearby. The 26-year-old male was found to have an outstanding Warrant and was jailed for the Warrant and Auto Theft.

- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported to a vehicle at 16XXX Gannon Way.
- Fraud Activity was reported at 17XXX Kenwood Trail. \$2,200.00 in counterfeit \$100's were passed by an unknown suspect via Money Gram.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 16XXX Pilot Knob Road, after an unknown suspect broke out the passenger window of a vehicle. Another vehicle there suffered Theft after a window was broken out and a purse containing cash and credit cards was stolen.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at Lakeville Boulevard and Cedar Avenue. One vehicle rolled over. No injuries were reported, but one driver was transported to the hospital for observation due to the severity of the crash.
- Officers responded to a minor Traffic Accident at Cedar Avenue and 160th Street West. The 39-year-old at-fault driver showed signs of intoxication. Field sobriety testing didn't go well. The driver tested a .27 BAC and was jailed for 2nd Degree DWI.
- Vehicle Theft was reported at 10XXX Jubilee Circle.
- Patrol was called to Check the Welfare of a subject who was apparently using drugs in his car at 21XXX Kenrick Avenue. On arrival, sure enough, he was in the process of injecting heroine and wouldn't open the door until he finished. Once he did, he was taken into custody on 5th Degree Drug Possession.
- Patrol responded to a Theft report at Hayes Avenue and Dodd Boulevard. A construction trailer was broken into and numerous tools were taken.
- Patrol made a Traffic Stop at 210th Street West and Hyacinth Avenue. The 58-year-old female driver showed signs of being under-the-influence. She failed SFST's and tested a .18 BAC. She was arrested for DWI.
- Catalytic converters were stolen off two vehicles parked at 16XXX Cedar Avenue.
- Vandalism was reported at 17XXX Kodiak Avenue. An older style SUV, pulling a boat, reportedly struck four mailboxes and left the scene without stopping.
- An 18-year-old male driver and another driver decided it would be a good idea to drag race each other on 202nd Street. As the vehicles approached the curve in the road, one driver lost control and went into the ditch. Luckily no one was injured. Unfortunately for them, Officers were across the street and witnessed the entire incident. They were both cited for Careless Driving.
- Patrol was dispatched to 17XXX Jackpine Trail on a Vehicle Theft report. Two vehicles were stolen from the residence. The garage had been left open and the keys were left in the unlocked vehicles.
