### Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Theft was reported at 8XXX 220<sup>th</sup> Street West. Avionic electronics, totaling almost \$45k, were stolen from locked planes on the tarmac.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at the following addresses:
  - 8XXX 176<sup>th</sup> Street West
  - 16XXX Fishing Way
  - 17XXX Hyacinth Way
- Officers responded to a family Disturbance over the intentional, and egregious act, of damaging a pack of cigarettes. The two parties involved engaged in a minor physical altercation and were separated for the evening.
- Theft of a catalytic converters were reported at:
  - 179<sup>th</sup> Street West and Gerdine Path
  - 17XXX Dodd Boulevard (2 separate thefts reported from this block)
  - 17XXX Ixonia Avenue
  - 17XXX Juniper Path
  - 17XXX Kenwood Trail
- Officers were dispatched to a Disturbance at Jonquil Avenue and Jasper Lane. It was reported an SUV was driving erratic in the area, with the driver yelling obscenities out the window. Patrol located the vehicle and driver. The 28-year-old female showed signs of impairment and failed SFST's. She tested a .16 BAC and was arrested for DWI. It was later discovered, she had previously crashed her vehicle into the garage door of a residence on Jonquil Avenue, causing significant damage. She also damaged the front entry door. Why this house? She discovered her boyfriend was a cheat and believed this was the address of the other female. Well, it wasn't. In addition to the DWI charge, she was also charged with Damage to Property.
- Officers were dispatched to a Domestic call and arrested a 41-year-old male for 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Domestic Assault and Reckless Discharge of a Firearm.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 9XXX 175<sup>th</sup> Street West after graffiti was found spray painted in the park.
- Patrol observed a suspicious vehicle driving very slow on 215<sup>th</sup> Street West. A quick search discovered the vehicle had been involved in burglaries and auto thefts. During the Traffic Stop, the 41-year-old female driver and 36-year-old male passenger didn't have a consistent story. A search of the vehicle revealed marijuana, methamphetamine, a loaded meth pipe, Sawzall, stolen checks, and a freshly cut catalytic converter. Both were arrested on multiple charges.
- Officers responded to a Traffic Accident at 17XXX Element Avenue. Upon arrival, the 33-year-old male at-fault driver showed signs of impairment. He failed SFST's and tested a .12 BAC. He was jailed for 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree DWI.
- Patrol conducted a Traffic Stop, at Godson Drive and Griffon Trail, and found the 44-year-old male driver intoxicated. He failed SFST's and tested a .22 BAC. He was jailed for 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree DWI.
