Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Please be sure to watch the roadways for deer! A Car vs Deer Traffic Accident occurred at 162nd Street West and Jaguar Avenue and another one occurred at Cedar Avenue and Lakeville Boulevard. In both cases, no human injuries were reported.
- A Damage to Property report was taken at 17XXX Gillette Way.
- Auto Theft was reported at 21XXX Cedar Avenue. A vehicle was purchased fraudulently under the identity and credit of a victim whose credentials were stolen. With the help of Apple Valley PD, the vehicle has been recovered.
- While assisting a separate Traffic Accident scene, a 36-year-old female was observed walking in the EB traffic lane on 160th Street West. She appeared heavily intoxicated, and it was discovered she had abandoned her running vehicle nearby. She failed SFST's and tested a .34 BAC. She was arrested for DWI.
- Burglary was reported from a garage at 17XXX Kerrick Court.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 17XXX Iceland Trail after a mailbox and small retaining wall were damaged by an unknown vehicle.
- Auto Theft was reported at 16XXX Firestone Way. The truck was left in the driveway, unlocked, with the keys in the ignition. Eagan PD later located the occupied vehicle at a gas station and the driver was taken into custody without incident.
- Catalytic converters were reported stolen from:
