- Patrol responded to 20XXX Heritage Drive for a Motor Vehicle Theft. The owner reported leaving the vehicle unlocked, with the keys near the center console.
- Officers arrested a 33-year-old male for past action Domestic Assault and Interfere with 911.
- Theft of license plates was reported at 20XXX Keokuk Avenue.
- Officers responded to a Domestic Disturbance. A 37-year-old female was arrested for 5th Degree Narcotics Warrant.
- Theft of catalytic converters were reported at:

- Patrol responded to 19XXX Juno Trail on a report of several Theft from Vehicle incidents. The unknown suspect(s) broke out vehicle windows and stole multiple items.

- A 53-year-old male was arrested for a DANCO Violation.
- Officers responded to a House Fire call at 7XXX Grinnell Way. A substantial amount of damage occurred to the rear side of the home and there was a great deal of smoke damage. Fortunately, no one was reported injured.
- Fraud Activity was reported after the victim's bitcoin account was hacked to the tune of nearly \$10K.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at Pilot Knob Road and 179th Street West. An EB car failed to obey the stop sign and struck a NB car. Three individuals were transported to the hospital with injuries.
- A Traffic Stop, at Iberia Avenue and 202nd Street West, resulted in the 4th Degree DWI arrest of a 23-year-old female. She failed SFST's and tested a .10 BAC.
