### Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Officers responded to a Shots Fired call. A witness saw the suspect shoot multiple rounds towards a home and drive off. Officers found the vehicle nearby and conducted a Traffic Stop. A 9mm handgun was found inside the vehicle and the 22-year-old male was taken into custody for Reckless Discharge of a Weapon and 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault.
- Officers responded to a Domestic call and issued a KOPS alert on a 37-year-old male for 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Domestic Assault and Interfere with 911.
- Fraud was reported after a victim paid \$400 for the purchase of a puppy on Facebook Marketplace. It turns out the seller and the puppy don't exist.
- Theft was reported from a construction site at 17XXX Evershed Way. Roof sheathing, valued at \$2500, was taken.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at:
  - 9XXX 176<sup>th</sup> Street West; a purse was taken from an unlocked vehicle
  - Ritter Farm Park (Monday); someone broke a vehicle window and stole the purse inside
  - Ritter Farm Park (Wednesday); unknown suspect(s) broke into two vehicles and grabbed purses containing credit cards and cash
  - Ritter Farm Park (Thursday); a window was broken out and a purse was stolen
- A car vs. deer Traffic Accident occurred at 19XXX Kenwood.
- Officers responded to a residential structure Fire at 18XXX Iroquois Way. Upon arrival, the home was almost fully engulfed in flames. LFD and AVFD joined forces to put it out. Fortunately, the homeowners were able to escape without injury.
- A residential Burglary was reported at 16XXX Kenmore Drive. The home appeared to have been "ransacked".
- Patrol responded to a Driving Complaint involving a vehicle driving with a flat tire. A Traffic Stop was conducted, and the 25-year-old male driver showed signs of alcohol impairment. He failed SFST's and tested a .18 BAC. He was arrested for DWI.
- Theft was reported at 18XXX Harlow Path. Two unknown males were observed stealing a package off the front porch.
- Officers responded to Trespass a 37-year-old male from 20XXX Holyoke Avenue.
