STAFF UPDATES

Finance Department

The 2018 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report was approved by the City Council on June 17 and is now available on the City's website.

Park Maintenance Division

A concrete floor and block was installed at Steve Michaud Park for a storage garage. The existing storage garage at Aronson Park—currently being used by the Lakeville Fastpitch Softball Association (LFSA)—will be moved to Steve Michaud Park and used for equipment storage for the Lakeville Soccer Association. A new garage will be constructed as part of the County Road 50/Aronson Park project and will be used by LFSA.

Work started on the new bocce ball courts at Aronson Park. Staff is working with Tree Trust to provide the installation of the timber border as their project for this year. Construction will take approximately five weeks.

Forestry Division

Staff added more than 100 ash trees to the right-of-way treatment inventory. Approximately 200 ash in City parks, at City facilities and along trails were treated with injections to protect them from emerald ash borer.
