### 2020 Census Canvassing

Address canvassing by Census Bureau workers was scheduled to begin this past week. Address canvassing is the process by which the U.S. Census Bureau validates, corrects or deletes existing Census Bureau addresses, adds missing addresses and adds or corrects locations of specific addresses before a decennial census. In previous address canvassing operations, field representatives traversed every road and visited each residential address in the United States. At this time, only select addresses will be canvassed. Census Bureau employees will not be asking for information about individuals but rather about addresses and habitable locations. Each temporary Census employee will have an official ID card with their name, picture and an expiration date.

The City Council has approved a preliminary and final plat for **Panera Bread** to develop a new restaurant near Super Target, located north of 185th Street, east of I-35 and west of Kenrick Avenue. The 4,294-square-foot building will seat approximately 100 people inside, 20 people outside and will include a drive-thru window.
