STAFF UPDATE

Park Maintenance

Staff met with a contractor that specializes in tennis/pickleball court construction and repair. The meeting provided information on and new processes and products for maintaining hard courts in our parks system.

Staff met with the contractors that will be completing the parking lot improvement project that includes lots at Aronson, Quigley-Sime and Dodd Trail parks. The project is expected to begin on Monday, August 17 at Aronson Park.

Staff installed a portable restroom enclosure at Aronson Park in the newly completed east parking lot and started the installation of an enclosure at Steve Michaud Park near Land of Amazement. An Eagle Scout is scheduled to install a third restroom enclosure at Ritter Farm Park.

Environmental Resources

Due to increased watercraft traffic, Level 1 Watercraft Inspectors have increased their aquatic invasive species inspections at the Lake Marion boat launch.

We received news from the MPCA that the City has met all the requirements to reach Step 3 in the GreenStep program. Formal recognition/awards will be given out in June 2021.

Facilities Maintenance

Proposals were received for the replacement of two sets of automated entrance doors at the Galaxie Liquor Store.

Additional protective screens were installed at the City Hall reception area and Building Inspections transaction counter.
