Weekly Review

- Burglary reported from a construction site at 10XXX Jubilee Circle.
- Vandalism reported at 21XXX Gateway Drive. A gate was smashed in.
- Smash-n-Grab Theft from Vehicles were reported at:
 - 18XXX Kenyon Avenue; two windows were smashed out and an amplifier and subwoofer were stolen
 - 11XXX 210th Street West; two pairs of golf shoes were stolen
 - 20XXX Kenrick Avenue; a box of tees and hats was stolen
 - 11XXX 205th Street West; a laptop was stolen
 - 11XXX 205th Street West; a laptop was stolen from another vehicle
 - 11XXX 205th Street West; \$500 cash, \$400 gift cards and numerous credit cards were stolen from another vehicle
 - 17XXX Glacier Way; multiple credit cards were stolen
- Patrol responded to Mills Fleet Farm for a person described to be under the influence. Officers located a 29-year old male who showed signs of impairment and he was instructed not to drive. Apparently he got the munchies because, an hour later, his vehicle was observed in a restaurant drive thru. He was arrested for Controlled Substance DWI.
- Officers responded to a commercial alarm at 16XXX Kenrick Loop. The unknown suspect(s) smashed the front window and stole two registers containing approximately \$500.
- Patrol responded to a Check the Welfare at Wendy's. An adult female, in the drive thru, reportedly drove over the curb and appeared to be under the influence. They located the 51-year old and arrested her for 3rd Degree DWI Test Refusal.
- Traffic Stop, at Cedar Avenue and Glacier Way, resulted in the 3rd Degree DWI arrest of a 30-year old male who tested a .18 BAC.
- Theft was reported from a new construction site at Hamburg Avenue and 200th Street West. A pallet of copper tubing and a box of valves was stolen. The total loss is estimated at \$11,300.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at 162nd Street West and Kenrick Avenue. No injuries were reported but the car was stuck under the semi-trailer and traffic was significantly backed up.
- Burglary was reported at 20XXX Holyoke Avenue. The cash drawer was damaged and the safe was wide open. The suspect(s) took \$375.
- Patrol took a report of Suspicious Activity after an unknown male was observed on a doorbell security camera aggressively trying to open the front door of a residence at 21XXX Ilavista Way. He is described as a balding white male, 40-50 years old, driving a blue truck.
- A 24-year old female was arrested for 3rd Degree DWI, at 16XXX Jalisco Way, after she provided a .18 BAC. The initial call came in from the suspect who claimed she was a victim of a Hit-n-Run. Her bumper and plate were found near a parked car that had been hit – by her!
