Weekly Review

- Vandalism/Property Damage reported at 9XXX Oak Shore Drive. The catalytic converter was stolen from the victim's car.
- LPD assisted Owatonna Police when a Domestic Assault from their city spilled into ours. The male suspect was arrested and taken into OPD custody.
- Theft of a political sign was reported from 16XXX Jackpine Trail.
- Responding to a Driving Complaint of erratic driving, Patrol arrested a 37-year old impaired male driver. He tested .21 and was booked for 2nd Degree DWI.
- Patrol responded to at least five (5) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Five (5) trucks at 17XXX Kenwood Trail were reported as having their catalytic converters stolen.
- After she fled the scene prior to Patrol's arrival, a KOPS alert was issued for a 40-year old female after a 911 hang-up call turned into a Domestic Assault/Interfere with Emergency Call.

- A Traffic Stop, at 185th Street West and Kabera Trail, resulted in a 57-year old male's arrest for 3rd Degree DWI. He tested a .22 BAC.
- Our Street Crimes Unit assisted with the arrest of a prolific burglar. The 44-year old male was arrested after committing multiple burglaries in Apple Valley.
- Patrol responded to a Vehicle Fire at Kenwood Trail and 162nd Street West. The vehicle was fully engulfed. Fortunately, no major injuries were reported.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 17XXX Kenyon Avenue. A male suspect broke into a machine and stole the change container.
- A vehicle Theft was reported at 10XXX 208th Street West.
- Theft of a bicycle reported from 20XXX Holyoke Avenue. The bike was locked to a rack, but the cable had been cut by an unknown suspect(s).
- Theft of a wallet reported from 10XXX 165th Street West. The victim left his wallet at the counter, while the clerk scanned his DL. Upon his return, the entire wallet was missing.
- A Traffic Stop, on Ipava Avenue, found the 33-year old male driver impaired. He failed SFST's, and tested a .13 BAC, before being booked for 4th Degree DWI.
