Weekly Review

- Patrol responded to at least five (5) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Officers served two neighbors with their Harassment orders against one another!
- A Theft from a construction trailer was reported from a Kenrick Avenue address. Unknown suspect(s) stole tools and equipment valued at \$10,000-\$15,000.
- Two catalytic converters were reported stolen from vehicles parked at 8XXX 205th Street West.
- A 21-year old male was jailed on 5th Degree Domestic Assault and Obstruction charges.
- A residential Burglary was reported at 20XXX Justice Path after the homeowner returned to discover a gun and \$1,000 cash was missing.
- A 42-year old male reportedly overdosed while in his vehicle at Walmart. An unknown female accomplice administered Narcan, left and called 911. On arrival, Patrol found him conscious and alert. He denied using drugs, was checked by Medics and denied further medical intervention. He was released and advised not to drive, as he has Driving After Cancellation status.
- Patrol responded to a Theft in Progress at Fleet Farm. A 26-year old male shoplifted a knife. He was arrested and jailed after being found to have 3 Felony Warrants for Burglary.
- Street Crimes and Investigations served a Warrant on a male who purchased a silencer, online, from out of the country. He was arrested on scene without incident.
- Parkview Elementary reported Vandalism/Property Damage to some windows on the property.
- A political sign was reported stolen from 21XXX Idaho Path and multiple political signs were reported stolen from 17XXX Jaguar Path
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 17XXX Fieldcrest Avenue. Two mailboxes were smashed by a vehicle which fled at a high rate of speed.
- A 35-year old male was stopped for Speeding on 162nd Street West. He showed signs of impairment and failed sobriety tests. His BAC was .17, so he was arrested for 3rd Degree DWI.
