Weekly Review

- Officers responded to at least seven (7) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 10XXX 165th Street. A building glass pane was smashed.
- A Burglary was reported at 21XXX Heron Way. Three sheds were broken into.
- Mail Theft was reported from 18XXX Kale Way.
- Patrol responded to a smoke alarm sounding off on the 5300 block of 173rd Street West. The source of the alarm was located and officers found the home filled with smoke. They were able to enter the home and remove the burning pot of food from the stove the homeowner had forgotten. LFD responded and assisted with expelling the smoke.
- A Traffic Stop, on 215th Street West, found the 30-year old male driver impaired. He failed SFST's and was arrested for 2nd Degree DWI after providing a .28 BAC.
- Patrol arrested a 46-year old male for an OFP Violation.
- Patrol conducted a Traffic Stop, for Speeding, on Cedar Avenue and Glacier Way. The driver said she couldn't find her ID and verbally ID'd herself as a 35-year old female. That name happened to have an outstanding Warrant. After hearing the terrible news, she advised she wasn't actually the 35-year old. Rather she was that woman's 37-year old sister! Well, she also had a Warrant and was arrested and jailed with some fresh charges for Driving after Revocation and GM False Information.
- Theft from Vehicle reported from 16XXX Javelin Avenue. A wallet was stolen.
- Theft of a catalytic converter was reported from 16XXX Cedar Avenue.
- Responding to a Disturbance/Disorderly Conduct call, Patrol arrested a 21-year old male for a DANCO Violation.
- A Traffic Stop, at Cedar Avenue and 190th Street, found the 24-year old male driver impaired. He provided a .10 BAC and was arrested for 3rd Degree DWI.
