Paper

- Newspapers and inserts
- Magazines and catalogs
- Mail and office papers



Cardboard & boxes

Flatten

- Corrugated cardboard
- Paperboard boxes (e.g. cracker boxes)



Cartons

Empty and dry; leave caps on.

- Milk, soup, broth and wine cartons
- Juice boxes



Leave these out.

- Appliances
- Batteries
- Black plastic
- Ceramic dishware
- Chains, cords, hoses, string lights
- Clothing and textiles
- Diapers
- Food and liquids
- Electronics
- Household hazardous waste
- Medications and sharps
- Paper plates, cups and napkins
- Plastic bags and wrap
- Propane tanks
- Shredded paper
- Styrofoam

Plastic

Empty and dry; leave caps on.

- Containers numbered



- Soda, juice and water bottles
- Milk and juice jugs
- Margarine, cottage cheese, cream cheese and other tubs and lids
- Laundry detergent bottles and jugs
- Clear berry and produce containers



Metal cans

Empty and dry

- Aluminum, tin and steel cans



Glass jars & bottles

Empty and dry; leave caps on.
