- Arts Center facility improvements
- Outdoor refrigerated covered ice rink at Hasse Arena
- Basketball court reconstruction
- Park identification sign replacements, plus much more.

Build new and connect existing trails throughout City

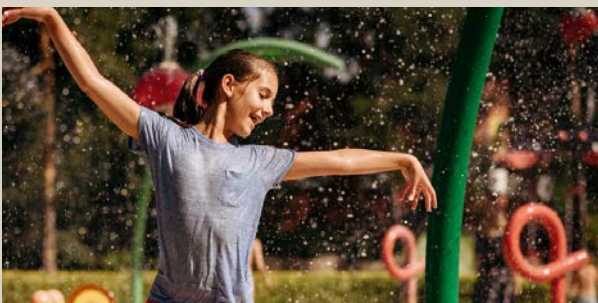


### **Improve Antlers Community Park**
